How Can I protect the Inheritances I leave to a Spouse?



A frequent estate planning objective is to prevent a spouse from losing his or her inheritance. You may also want to insure that your spouse will eventually bequeath your assets to beneficiaries of your choice which are usually children from a former marriage. To accomplish this calls for a Q-Tip or Qualified Terminable Interest Property trust which gives your spouse lifetime income from the trust. But once your spouse dies or remarries, the trust principal passes to your children or whatever other beneficiaries that you designate.
